

MORE THAN 16000 POLICE PERSONNEL TO PERFORM DUTIES ON EID.

Karachi 28-7-14: The IGP Sindh Ghulam Hyder Jamali has ordered fool proof security measures during Namaz-e-Eid and Eid holidays. He was visiting different areas and shopping markets of city last night. He was accompanied by Addl. IGP Karachi, Zonal DIsG and District SSsP. He also visited various Police Reporting Centers established in the city in connection with the Ramadan Contingency Plan. He was informed that more than 60 such Police Reporting Centers have been established extending all possible assistance to the citizens. During his visit, IGP Sindh also broke fast with the police personnel/staff of PS Gulberg for their encouragement.

IGP was further informed that more than 16000 police personnel will be performing duties on Eid Day. "Police would be providing security around more than 336 open places for Namaz-e-Eid congregations, 3993 masajids and 312 Imambargahas," according to the eid contingency plan. Karachi Police is also deploying Police Commandos at various possible sensitive/crime infested areas and vital installations. IGP directed to stream-line the responsibilities under a pro-active policing mechanism with special reference to reactivation of Advance Intelligence Collection Units at the level of Police Stations.

IGP directed on the occasion that Police Officers should visit the residences of Shaheed police personnel along with gifts for the kids to let them feel that the police department owns them. He said that the families of Shaheed police personnel should be looked after properly and problems rectified. He was informed that a complaint box has been fixed at the main gate of CPO to specially receive any complaint from family members of police shaheeds whereas a desk has been established in the office of AIG Welfare to address issues/problems confronting to the families of police shaheeds.

IGP also directed to gear-up the targeted operation in the city and ensure arrest of criminals/terrorists involved in killing & other crimes, without any discrimination. He warned the police that any slackness and irresponsibility would not be tolerated.

Ghulam Hyder Jamali also visited residence of Allama Talib Jouhari to offer condolences over killing of his son-in-law, few days ago. IGP remained there for some time and expressed sympathies to the bereaved family members. He ensured that the killers would be brought to book very soon. He also visited Aga Khan Hospital and met prominent Ahl-e-Tashi leader Salman Mujtaba to enquire about health of his niece who got injured due to firing incident a few days ago. IGP also enquired the health and well being of DSP Tariq Saeed got injured due to firing of terrorists at the Police mobile. He issued directive that expenditure on treatment of injured police personnel would be borne by the Police Department.#
