HOME DEPARTMENT

Karachi, the 5th June 1974

No. XX(32)-SOJ/72.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1898, and in continuation of the Home Department Notification of even number, dated the 1st December, 1973, appointing Mr. Nayar Bari, Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Cantonment Sub-Division, Karachi, to be a Special Magistrate for the trial of the case state versus Mahmoodul Haq Usmani, the Government of Sind are pleased to extend the period of appointment of the said Special Magistrate for a further period of six months upto 21st November, 1974.

No. E&A(HD)2-2/74.—Mr. Ahmed Khan Barkzai, formerly District and Sessions Judge, Dadu who was relieved in the afternoon of 3rd April 1974, assumed the charge of the office of the Member of the Special Tribunal, Sind with effect from the forenoon of 8th April, 1974, against a newly created post. The period from 4th April, 1974 to 7th April 1974 (both days inclusive) is hereby treated as joining time.

No. POL-HD-2-42/73.—In pursuance of sub-rule (2) of rule 3 of Sind Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion & Transfer) Rules, 1974, the following method of recruitment, qualifications and other conditions are laid down for appointment to the posts of Deputy Superintendents of Police in Grade 16:—

- (1) *Method of appointment*:—Appointment to the post shall be by promotion or transfer or initial appointment as the Appointing Authority may decide.
- (2) *Conditions for promotion*:—Promotion to the post of Deputy Superintendents of Police shall be made by selection from amongst the persons holding the posts of Inspectors of Police with at least five years experience as such, provided that the Government may relax this condition in suitable cases.

(3) *Condition of transfer*.—Appointment by transfer shall be made from amongst such persons who hold appointments on a regular basis in the same grade in which the posts of Deputy Superintendents of Police exist, and possesses the physical standards and the academic qualifications laid down for direct recruitment and has completed the training of at least one year and passed tests/examination from a recognized Police Training School.

(4) *Qualifications for direct recruitments*.—No person shall be appointed as Deputy Superintendent of Police by initial recruitment unless he is a graduate from a recognized University or holds an equivalent qualification from a recognized University or Institution and has a minimum height of 5'—5" and chest measurement of 32" with an expansion of 1½".

(5) *Age*.—A candidate for the post of Deputy Superintendent of Police by initial recruitment shall not be less than eighteen years or more than twenty-eight years of age, provided that Government may, in individual cases, relax the upper and lower age limit.
