Invitation to Bid

Instruction to bidder

- i. The bidder is expected to examine the Bidding Documents, including all instructions, forms, terms, specifications and charts/drawings. Failure to furnish all information required by the Biding documents or submission of a Bid not substantially responsive to the Bidding Documents in every respect would result in the rejection of the Bid.

On or before 1430 hours on 14.11.2019. The bids will be publicly opened in the Conference Room of TRO Ground Floor at 1500 hours on the same day in presence of bidders who wish to remain present.
- v. The Police Department, Government of the Sindh will not be responsible for any costs or expense incurred by bidders in connection with the preparation or delivery bids.
- vi. Bidders shall submit bids, which comply with the bidding documents. For alternate bids, bidder has to purchase separate bidding documents and alternate bid shall be treated as separate bid.

i) Bid Bond

iii) Currency

All currency in the proposal shall be quoted in Pakistan Rupees (PKR).

iv) Withholding Tax, Sales Tax and other Taxes

The responding organization is hereby informed that the Government shall deducted tax at the rate prescribed under the tax laws of Pakistan, from all payments for services rendered by any responding organization who signs a contract with the Police department.  - **Mode of payment:** on monthly basis 100% after verification of bills by SP Traffic of concerned District.
 - Release of performance guarantee after completion contract period.

No appeal or review will be permissible against the decision of inspection committee.

- iii) That the services (provision of labours) approved shall be paid by the **DIGP/Traffic Karachi** at the rate specified below (For Destination).

- iv) In case **M/s.** _____ make default provision of labour in time as per this agreement/contract regarding supply of labour as demanded by Traffic Police Karachi, The **DIGP/Traffic Karachi** shall be at liberty to impose and recover Fine equal to wages of a labour in a day (which is define by contractor) from the contractor against each absent labour.
- v) In case of damaging Govt: Vehicle (Towing & Lifting vehicle) and also private vehicle which will be lifted / towed by the labour the repairing cost will be borne by contractor subject to the finding of committee headed by the gazzeted officer not below BPS-18, constituted by the DIGP Traffic Karachi.
- vi) The **DIGP Traffic Karachi** shall not be responsible for non-performance of this agreement due to change in law, rules and policy of the government as notified in official gazette from time to time.
- vii) That all conditions laid down in the rules framed for procurement by the Government shall apply to transactions made under this contract agreement and both parties shall be bound by it.
- viii) In case of any accident / death the contractor shall be held responsible after finding of committee headed by the gazzeted officer not below BPS-18, constituted by the DIGP Traffic Karachi.
- ix) In case of any emergency situation (force majeure) the contractor shall be bound to provide their services continuously without any cost (Labour charges) where the Traffic Police not charging fine (Lifting & Towing Charges) from the owner / driver of vehicle.
- x) In case of any dispute relating to the agreement both the parties will negotiate on their senior executives level who will submit the recommendations to the DIGP Traffic Karachi who is final authority to take decision.
- xi) If the Karachi Traffic Police unsatisfied by the service performance of the contractor at any time during contract period the DIGP Traffic Karachi is a liberty to terminate the contract.

11- This contract agreement shall be construed, and the legal relations created herein will be determined in accordance with the laws of Islamic Republic of Pakistan.

12- Any notice required under this contract agreement shall be in writing and shall be effective when received by the addressee at its given address.

- 13- If any term, conditions, or provision in this Agreement is found to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable to any extent, the parties shall endeavour in good faith to agree to such amendments that will preserve, as far as possible, the intentions expressed in the Agreement. Verbatim of SPPRA Rule 14.

Approval Mechanism - All procuring agencies shall provide clear authorization and delegation of powers for different categories of procurement and shall only initiate procurements once approval of the competent authorities concerned has been accorded.
