Subject: MINUTES OF MEETING ON IMPLEMENTATION OF MINORITIES RIGHTS JUDGMENT (SMC NO. 1 OF 2014 DATED 19<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 2014) OF THE SUPREME COURT OF PAKISTAN.

A meeting was chaired by the former IGP Sindh Dr. Muhammad Shoaib Suddle (Single-member Commission on Minorities Rights' at Supreme Court of Pakistan) on 11-11-2020 (Wednesday) @ 1000 hours at 6<sup>th</sup> Floor Ibrahim Hall CPO Sindh, Karachi.

Meeting started with recitation of Holy Quran, Chair welcomed to all the participants.

3. Following decisions were taken in the meeting:-

S#	Decisions Taken	Action by taken
1.	Registration of all worship places of minorities in Sindh should be updated and geo-tagged.	DIGP Special Branch to coordinate and monitor
2.	Security audit of all worship places of minorities should be carried out by taking their local representatives onboard.	DIGP Special Branch to coordinate and monitor
3.	Safety and security of worship places of minorities should be ensured across the Province by smart deployment and supervision at district level.	Addl: IsGP and DIsGP to ensure
4.	Paradigm shift in working culture of Sindh police is needed in its relationship with religious minorities. This should be achieved by sensitizing both officers and rank and file on the issue as well as by outreach programs.	Addtl IsGP and DIsGP
5.	Special cells, one each in CPO, Special branch, offices of Additional IsGP Karachi, Hyderabad and Sukkur, all field DIsGP and District SSsP should be established to deal with matters relating to religious minorities.	All concerned

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6.	A committee under chairmanship of Secretary Services with a representative from Police and AG office will be notified soon. The committee may be consulted regarding any issues including interpretation of law vis-a-vis minority matters.	All concerned
7.	Separate file folders should be maintained at all offices relating to matters of minorities	All concerned
8.	Matter pertaining to lodging of false FIR vide number 91/2020 u/s 381-A PPC at police station Khipro, district Sanghar against one Mukesh Kumar, was raised by the Chairman. Additional IGP Hyderabad explained the facts and circumstances of the case comprehensively to the satisfaction of the Chairman. The Chairman, however, directed to devise a mechanism whereby no such false FIRs are lodged in future. And if any FIR is lodged, it should only lead to arrest of the nominated accused when the IO is satisfied that enough evidence has been placed on record to necessitate it.	All concerned
9.	Illegal encroachments on the properties pertaining to minorities by land mafias should be vacated by adhering to law and taking civil administration on board across the Province. One such illegal occupation in Golimar area of District West, Karachi, was highlighted by Mr. Ramesh Kumar, MNA. DIGP West was directed by the chair to take up the matter with the concerned deputy commissioner and provide him police support without let or hindrance to vacate the subject land.	DIGP West
10	Forced conversions of underage girls is bringing bad name to Pakistan at international level. Police can play a lead role by responding quickly in cases where abduction is reported. A committee of experienced police officers should be established for comprehensive study of the issue. It should come up with effective countermeasures and recommendations within ten days.	DIGP Headquarter
11	A formal input mechanism should be devised for inviting proposals from different field formations for establishing 'special police force' for protection of minority worship places. A committee of senior police officers should be established for recommending the structure, organization, training and discipline of the proposed force in ten days.	DIGP Headquarter
12	Five per cent job quota of minorities in Sindh Police should be ensured and clearly mentioned in all job advertisements. Special coaching of minority youth may be considered if the quota is not fully utilized by them due to any reason. Any left-over seats should be carried forward to the next recruitment.	DIGP Establishment

13	Police officers posted in districts should regularly be sensitized on the fundamental rights of every minority community of the Province so that the collective and individual rights of everyone are ensured. This may be done by mentioning the status of minorities in DO letters, and more importantly by highlighting it in Annual Policing Plan of Sindh Police.	DIGP Establishment
14	Print, electronic and social media should be regularly briefed on minority issues. Success stories relating to minority affairs should be shared with them for wider publication at national and international levels. Any adverse news should be countered in a timely and effective manner.	All concerned
15	The Commission should be apprised of any good work done by Sindh Police with regards to protection of minority rights for keeping it on record.	AIGP Operations
